

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR FREE PRIZE DRAW
TO WIN A SIGNED COPY OF MICHAEL MORPURGO'S NEW BOOK *FLAMINGO BOY*, OR WIN
A PAIR OF TICKETS TO THE AWARD-WINNING PLAY *WAR HORSE* FOR YOUR FAVOURITE
TEACHER.**

Conditions of entry

1. This prize draw (the "**Promotion**") is only open to residents of England, Wales and Northern Ireland, excluding employees and agents of (a) the Promoter or (b) any company connected with the production or distribution of this Promotion, as well as their relatives or members of their family or household.
2. The Promotion is free to enter and entrants can enter by visiting <http://teachingawards.com/thank-a-teacher>. Entrants will be directed to the Thank a Teacher Card page where they will enter their details (full name and email address) along with the details of the teacher to whom they would like to say thank you, and click submit to enter the Promotion. Only one entry will be accepted per person or email address, regardless of how many teachers an individual sends thank you cards to.
3. Individuals who do not submit their name will not be eligible to enter the competition.
4. The Promotion will start at 09.00 26th January 2018 ("Opening Date") and close at midnight on 9th March 2018 ("Closing Date").

Winner

5. Each week, 4 books will be awarded to entrants who have completed the Thank a Teacher Card form, chosen at random, and 2 pairs of tickets will be allocated to teachers thanked through Thank A Teacher.
6. The prize draws will take place weekly between 2nd February 2018 and 9th March 2018, excluding 16th February. Winners of the prizes will be announced weekly during the Promotion Period. The winners will be notified by the Promoter by email within one week of these dates and will be given details of how to accept their prize. The prize will then take up to 28 days from the first point of contact with the winner, to be delivered. Failure by the winner(s) to accept the prize in the manner specified within one week of the Promoter's email will make any claim invalid and the Promoter will then select another winner (again selected randomly in a draw) from all remaining eligible entries who will be contacted as above.
7. Copies of Michael Morpurgo's new book, *Flamingo Boy*, will be published on 8th March. The book will not be available before this date.

General

10. The determination and decision of the Promoter on all matters shall be final and no promotional correspondence or discussion will be entered into. The Promoter reserves the right in its

reasonable discretion: (a) to disqualify any claimant, competitor or nominee whose conduct is contrary to the spirit of the rules or the intention of the promotion and to declare as void any or all of their claims or entries based on such conduct; (b) to declare as void any claims or entries resulting from any printing, production and/or distribution errors (including but not limited to any error(s) on any website, any game cards and/or other printed materials) or where there has been error(s) in any aspect of the preparation for or conduct of the promotion materially affecting the result of the promotion or the number of claimants or the value of claims; (c) to add to or to waive any rules on reasonable notice; and/or (d) to cancel the promotion or any part of it at any stage in the event of circumstances beyond the Promoter's reasonable control.
